- From whose point of view is this text being presented? Are there other perspectives represented? Are there voices that are missing from this text?
- Does the author make any assumptions or contradictions?
- Does the time period this was written in have any affect on the text or author? Are there any social or cultural factors that may affect the text or author?

Is this reasonable?

Are there any missing voices or perspectives that are not being considered here?

What assumptions are being made? Is there a political perspective being favoured here?
